## **Bronze Medallion – June 1 – 3**

The Bronze Medallion award teaches an understanding of the lifesaving principles embodied in the four components of water rescue education: judgment, knowledge, skill, and fitness.

Rescuers learn tows and carries, and defense and release methods in preparation for challenging rescues of increased risk, involving conscious and unconscious victims of various types. Participants also develop stroke efficiency and endurance in timed swims. As well as treatment skills for many circulatory emergencies.

## **Bronze Cross – June 8 – 10**

Designed for lifesavers who want the challenge of more advanced training, including an introduction to safe supervision in aquatic environments. Students learn the differences between lifeguarding and lifesaving while continuing to develop the basic principles of emergency procedures and teamwork. Lifesavers further increase their stroke efficiency, fitness and endurance

Bronze Cross is a prerequisite for all advanced training programs, including Lifesaving Instructor, National Lifeguard Service, and Distinction certification.

## **National lifeguard – July 9 – 13**

National Lifeguard certification is Canada's professional lifeguard standard. National Lifeguard training develops a sound understanding of lifeguarding principles, good judgment, and a mature and responsible attitude towards the lifeguard's role. National Lifeguard training emphasizes prevention and effective rescue response in emergencies including first aid treatment. Candidates develop teamwork, leadership and communication skills. Fitness requirements include a timed object recovery, 50 m sprint challenge, 50 m rescue drill and 400 m endurance challenge.
